INDIVIDUAL GRANTS APPLICATION POLICY

PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ THIS INFORMATION BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

Grants will be made to individuals that are contributing to the educational, cultural, social, and relationship development of Māori from and/or living in Taranaki.

PKW Trust recognises significant achievements of current PKW Shareholders and/or their beneficiaries when representing New Zealand in international sporting events and cultural/arts events of international significance. This recognition has also been extended now to include participation in National events.

However grant funding will only be used for activity related to NZ based activity ONLY and does NOT include travel related expenses.

This means that priority funding will go to individuals selected at a national level for a national or international event or fixture but the funding can only be used towards costs associated with their preparation or/and activity based in Aotearoa. Funding support for participation at a National event will be dependent on the funding available for distribution.

To be eligible for a grant you must be a current PKW **Shareholder** or **Beneficiary** (child, mokopuna) of a current PKW Shareholder and provide the following information to support your application:

- **Confirmation** by letter from a National Organisation (e.g. NZRFU, NZTE), of your selection to a national team/group for a national or international fixture or event; eg.
- New Zealand **Representative** in Official National Sports Team playing an **International Fixture** against another country's National Sports Team e.g. New Zealand Women's Under 21 Softball Team versus Australian Women's Under 21 Softball Team;

OR

- New Zealand **Representative** in an International Cultural/Arts Event e.g. World Expo

The individual will need to provide bank account details to receive a grant. Alternatively, PKW Trust may approve direct payment to a supplier of goods/services for the individual e.g. a specialist coach, a national sports organisation.

PKW Trust has limited funds for this type of award. Applications will be considered on their merits and PKW Trust has sole discretion to assess applications and to award grants. The maximum amount available for each application is \$500.

Individuals are eligible to apply for only one award in any one financial year under each category (Sport, Culture/Art).

PKW Trust may require additional information e.g. brief report, invoices, in order to transfer payment of an award. This additional requirement will be noted at the time the notification of the award is given.
